## Miami Township Bridge 63-1.38 to Remain Closed for Replacement Using Federal Aid Funding

The Logan County Engineer's Office announces that Miller Bros. Construction, Inc. will be continuing the total replacement of Bridge 63-1.38 located over CSX Railroad in Miami Township on County Road 63 between the Quincy Corporation limit and County Road 64.

The closure of Bridge 63-1.38 will continue until the weather allows temperature sensitive items to be incorporated into the project. Weather permitting; the project should be completed early in the spring of 2009. The bridge will continue to remain closed until substantial completion of the construction phase can be achieved.

The project will be paid for with 90% Federal Aid Funding and 10% Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax Funding.

Access to the Miami Valley Campground will continue to be maintained and can be accessed from the East by following S.R. 508 to S.R. 235 in DeGraff, S.R. 235 South to Quincy, New Street East in Quincy to C.R. 63 East to the campground.

The closure and superstructure replacement of Bridge 63-2.63 over Stony Creek between DeGraff and County Road 64 will be delayed until the completion of the current CSX railroad bridge project.

The posted detours are unchanged and will remain in place until further notice.

The postponement in completion is due to delays by the steel mill and excusable weather delays.
