BID GUARANTY – BID BOND

The bidder shall file with the bid a bid guaranty in the amount of five hundred dollars, in the form of a corporate check, certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Revised Code. The bond shall be made payable to the Logan County Treasurer. Any such letter of credit is revocable only at the option of the county.

Bonds shall be released provided that the bid is accepted and the bidder, after the awarding of the contract, enters into a proper contract in accordance with the bid, plans, details, and specifications.

If for any reason, the bidder fails to enter into the contract, and the contracting authority awards the contract to the next lowest bidder, the bidder and the surety on the bidder's bond are liable to the county for a penal sum not to exceed the amount of the bond. If county does not award the contract to the next lowest bidder but resubmits the project for bidding, the bidder failing to enter into the contract is liable to the county a penal sum not to exceed the amount of the bond for the costs in connection with the resubmission of printing new contract documents, required advertising, and printing and mailing notices to prospective bidders.

Bid guaranties filed pursuant to this section shall be returned to all unsuccessful bidders immediately after the contract is executed.
