

Plot of Town City Addition to Allefontaine Ohio

The annexed Plot is a correct representation of 117 lots with the adjacent streets & alleys so surveyed by the Surveyor on the day of Ad 1892, by the request and direction of the Quakeman Iron Bridge Company, proprietors, and being part of the N. E. quarter of section 17. 33. Town 11. Range 14. M. R. 2. in the Township of Lake, in the County of Logan State of Ohio the Plot containing 23 acres of land to be known and designated as the Town City Addition to the Town of Allefontaine. The second Street & Third Street are each 60 feet wide and broad 40 E. Mag. Men Liberty Avenue & Brown Avenue are at right angles with said streets and are also each 60 feet wide and all the alleys are ^{each} 15 feet wide, and all the alleys and lot lines not otherwise marked are at right angles or parallel with said streets and Avenues. The lots thereon are all 45 feet in width and 135 feet in depth, except lot No. 1932, which is 52 feet in width and 135 feet in depth; also fractional lot No. 1899 which is 52 feet in width ^{and} 64 feet front on said Barlike Avenue. Lots Nos. 1848, 1849, 1850, 1900 and 1901 are each 45 feet wide ^{and} 56 feet front on said Barlike Avenue. Lot No. 1851 is 45 feet wide ^{and} 33 1/4 feet front on Third Street, and 13 3/4 feet front on Barlike Avenue. Fractional lots Nos. 1872, 1873 and 1874 are here by given and dedicated to public use as and for the purpose of a Park. The length of each fractional lot line is specified in said plot. The streets, Avenues & Alleys as designated in said plot are also hereby given and dedicated to the public for public use as well. Town Pins marked "CROSS" respectively 1/4 in. in diameter mark intersection of Main Street with Liberty Avenue & Brown Avenue and S. line of South Alley and intersection of Barlike Avenue with Main Street. The N. W. Corner line of said addition is 30 feet distant at every point S. E. from center of Barlike Pike. Said Addition is marked by the West line of Third Street its Western boundary.
