PROTECTIVE

COVENANTS

These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them for a period of Twenty-Five years from the date these covenants are recorded, after which time said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of 10 years unless an instrument signed by the majority of the then owners of the lots has been recorded, agreeing to change said covenants in whole or in part. Enforcement shall be by proceedings at law inequity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any covenant either to restrain violation on to recover damages.

Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgement or court order shall in no way effect ony of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect. No let shall be used except for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on any let other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two and one-half stories in height and a private garage for not more than two cars.

No dwelling shall be permitted an any lot at a cost of less than \$7,500 be based upon cost levels prevailing on the date these covenants are recorded, it being the intention and purpose of the covenant to assure that all dwellings shall be of a quality of workmanship and materials substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the date these covenants are recorded at the minimum cost stated herein for the minimum permitted dwelling size. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open perches and garages, shall be not less than 720 square feet for a one-story dwelling, nor less than 540 square feet for a dwelling of more than one-story.

No building shall be located on any lot nearer to the front lot line or nearer to the side street line than the minimum building set back lines shown on the recorded plat. In any event no building shall be located on any lot nearer than 25 feet to the front lot line, or nearer than 25 feet to any side street line building shall be located nearer than 5 feet to an interior lot line, except that no side yard shall be required for a garage or other permitted accessory building located Go feet or more from the minimum building betback line. For the purposes of this covenant, eaves, steps, and open porches shall not be another lot.

No dwelling shall be erected or placed on any lot having a width of less than 65 feet at the minimum setback line nor shall any dwelling be erected or placed on any lot having an area of less than 8000 square feet.

Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat and over the rear 5 feet of each lot.

No nexious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or may become an annoyance or nuisance
to the neighborhood.

No structure of a temporary character, trailer, besement, tent, shack, garage or other outbuildings shall be used on any lot at any time as a residence either

temporarily or permanently.

No sign of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any let except one professional sign of not more than One square foot, one sign of not more than 5 aquare feet advertising the property for adle or rent, or signs used by a builder to advertise the property during the construction and sales period. No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any let, except that dogs, cats or other household pets may be kept provided that they are not kept, bred, or maintained for any commercial purpose.


