For action of Joint Board of Dominissioners of Hardin and Logan Counties see Commissioners Record under dates of Nov 13th and Nov 26th 1883 and also see same for action of Joint Board of Commissioners of anylaige Hardin and Logan Counties under dates of Dec 28th 1883 Nov 10th 1884 Nov 25th 1884 and Jan 21st 1885 under order dated June 12th 1830 issued by Logan County Commissioners to James W Marmon to Surveyor of Logan Dounty the said Mannon surveyed and established the line between Loglan and Hardin Counties for a distance of 22 miles west from the NE Dorner of Logan County. Said comer being also by him located and established in this survey. This survey was completed in 1832 and was afterwards known as the Marmon Line. Under order of said Commis Lines dated Jan 19th 1837 Daniel Hopkins Dounty Surveyor of Logan Sounty Surveyed and established the north line of Logan County west ward from the west sud of the Marmon Line to the north west comer of Logan lounty and also at same time as much of the west line of Logan County as was included between the south east corner of allen Sounty (afterwards Domer to any laige and Shelby Counties) and the north west corner of Logan County, a copy of the above named orders and the returns of surveys made thereunder by Marmon and Hopkins and also a copy of agoresaid senate bill N 339 is hereunto attached and made a fact of this return

the undersigned surveyors had in their firesession during this work all the evidence maps plats and testimony sollected and compiled and also. the finished Accord in the saxe of "Abour Riddle et al os Board of Commissioners of Hardin So et al " in which was much valuable information in reference to the Irealism and marking of the Marmor line. A full and complete copy of all the field notes for all lines and surveyor made in connection with this work will be found in the Records of Soundy Surveyors Office as required by law and are mitted therefore from this return. Insurant to instructions from the Joint Board of Auglaige Hardin and Logan Soundies at meeting held at Kenton O Dee 28 1883 Soundy Surveyors Samuel Graig of Auglaige County" N H Solvell of Hardin County and Lamuel A Buchaman of Logan Co

met on the 18th day of Feb 1884 at the NW corner of Logan County for the purpose of locating and establishing said Corner, upon finding that this comer would fall somewhat within a cleared field and all comer trees marked by Hopkins and all evidence and marks in that immediate vicinity feet aining thereto wholly removed it was during best to begin at the corner of any large and Shelby Counties in west line of I ogan County, (Hopkins place of beginning) and produce the line northward to the IVW comer of Logan Churty, Iwo serious errors in distances given by Hopkens were now discovered which made it impossible to locate the corner positively and definitely by his metes and bounds, at a distance of 295 chains a temporary post was taken and from this frost a random line was run & 886 503 chains to the west side of the round prairie, so called in Auroug 12276 and 12277 No Original marks were found on this live until at 238/2 chains a trickory stump old and decaying was found which had been about 24 inches in diameter and proved to be the umains of one of the original line trees, and the only evidence left of the west said of the Marmon live at his 22 mile frost, from this place to the round frairie many marked trees were found, all being marked the same way and in a practically straight line east and west. The Marmon line was originally marked in the timber by three backs spaced from one foot to 18 inches apart out in both the east and west sides of line trees, these marks were each made by a single right hand stroke and covered a space varying from 3 to 6 feet from the ground and were all made with the same heavy hatchet (Tomahawk) or light are with a rounded bit which out an incresion about 3 inches in length, on account of water in round france and wet lands immediately east of it work on the line was temporarily suspended. On Deplember 8th 1884, Durvey or Gray Buchanan and Colwell met at the N 6 comes of Logan County and resumed work on the line, The lourse of the east line of the Lounty was found to be & 2''n W and a berea stone monument planted several years before by the Survey ors of union and Logan Counties for the Northeast corner of Logan County was found to be at the County Dorner as located by Marmon in 1830, From the NE Comer of Logan County as above a random live was new N87" sto (being at right angles by bearing to east line of Lounty) 338'n chains to the west line of survey No 10239 several well marked trees were found on the mannor line south of random line and at a constantly increasing distance from it. It was thought best by the Surveyors to start a Transit line, with required correction in sources. which beginning at the N. E. Corner of Logan County would follow the marrion live throughout. All lives up to this time had been new by magnetic bearings; by a "railro ad telescope compass (Randolph lin O maker) which was comparatively new and in excellent working order, On Dept 11 1884 a transit line was started from the north east come of Sigan County on the course N. 87010' a and was soutimed to a distance of 2000 chains (a little more , than 25 miles) to a first in center of public road and in the

range live between ranges Nos 7 and 8 and in the west live of section No 6 Town 6 Range 8 and at 3,97 chains north of the south west comer of said section 6 paxing 28 34 Thairs north of the Northwest comer of Logan Que

In running the above transit line it was discovered that local attraction existed throughout the first ten miles of its length such that a line new westward by magnetic bearings was constantly deflected south by which such line instead of being a straight line was an irregular surve somewhat resembling a partola, during the remaining 15 miles local attraction was still inducated by southern deflection but greatly diminished in effect loward the west end, after the yth mile no marks of marmons line were found though caugal examination was made of all timber within 20 foles on each side of transit line On Nov 19 1884 Surveyors Graig and Buch awan began on Marmon line at west side of "round prairie and utraced said line wist ward to 22 mile frost at old hickory strong finding the line well and plainly marked but none of Marmons marks could be found west of the 22 mile frost as above and on Dec 3d 1884 same Surveyors began at same place of beginning and traced the Marmon line eastward to frost near the east line of survey 14159 about I mile north of Bellecutre

On January 3 1885 survey or Crain and Colwell began survey of Hardin and auglaige to line at Deioto River and located same southward to intersection of Mannon line at which fromt the corner between said Sounties was established. From evidence so far collected as to location of Marmon live the surveyors made a report to Societ Board of Commissioners of the three Counties at meeting at Stenton Jan 21de 1885 and a live was proposed and recommended in said report Which it was believed would practically follow and be identical to localing the mannon line (a copy of said report is hereunto appended. and when produced eastward to the free fike running north and south in survey 9997 fell 13,9 links south of froint then made for county line. Between this froint and the west line of survey 10239 an unexpected angle and previously unknown angle it the Marmon line required that an angle of 14' 16" south should be to south in the Country live at fike and new from thence to point of angle in transit line Nov at west live of Survey No 10239 and from thence the Lounty live should follow transit line No 2 to the northeast come of Logan County all three surveyors fully agreeing in the above it was decided to locate and mark the County line as follows, Beginning at the north east come of Logan County. Thence by transit line No 2 to West live of Durvey Nº 10239 Thence deflecting south 29' (twenty nine minutes) a straight line to froint on free file in survey 9997. Thence deflecting south 14'16" (fourteen minutes and six Cen seconds) a straight line to the anglaige and Hardin Co Corner in Survey 12276. This line as just described follows faithfully the spirit of the statute in the matter and places the marked live trees on Mannons live as nearly equal in number and distances on north and south sides of the County line as was considered possible to do and no near approximation to the Marmon live lould be made unless the line be run from one marked tree to the next which would introduce a multitude of angles almost equal to the number of trees and was therefore not practical, about 50 of the marked line trees, were by us blocked, and the age of the marks as indicated by the timber growth was found to average from 50 to 50 years. Which report we all agree as king extremely vague and unreliable, to a point in the sast line of Virginia Military No 12276 in Round fraince. finding no marks considered reliable west of a froint near line between Black Heirs, and Elizabeth Disons land Beech No 21

From here to round fraisie several trees were found whose rings or growths plainly from that 50 years have elapsed since they were marked.

discovered the original Marmon line, it was deemed advisable to start at the northeast come of Loyan County and run west on said line to a point above named

On the 8th day of November 1884, began at stone NE armons live West by marked trees four and one half miles. The foregoing surveys were

made by magnetic bearings. It was now thought advisable to begin again at the NE somer of Logan lounty and run a transit live which should follow the Marmon live as above described To this end the necessary galantations from data oftained in about four and one half miles was made and the Francit live started on a bearing of N 87° 10' West. Said Transit line was continued westward past the west live of Hardin County to a frost in road on lange line beliveer Ranges of and 8 near the Well comer of Logan County.
