ORDINANCE NO. 349

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE REPORT OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO, FOR THE ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLE CENTER, OHIO.

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio, on October 16, 1950, granted the prayer of the petition filed by Richard H. Finebrock, former Solicitor for the Village of Belle Center, Ohio, asking that certain territory containing 6.70 acres as shown on plat attached, and lying adjacent to the Village of Belle Center, Ohio, be annexed to said village, and

WHEREAS more than sixty days have expired after the filing of final transcript of these proceedings with the Clerk of the Village of Belle Center, Ohio,

Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Belle Center, Ohio, that the application of Richard H. Finebrock, former Solicitor for the Village of Belle Center, for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Logan and adjacent to the Village of Belle Center, to-wit:

Situated in the County of Logan, in the State of Ohio, and in the Township of Richland, and bounded and described as follows: Being in V.M.S. 9989 and 12181 and commencing at an iron pin at the intersection of the center lines of Buckeye Street and Main Street in the Village of Belle Center at Station 201 plus 77.8 of State Highway # 593 (Route 273) as shown on Page 5 of Logan County Highway Plats # L-13; thence northwesterly with the center line of said S.H. 593, which follows a 3° curve to the left, whose radius is 1910.08 feet, 411.0 feet to an iron pin at Station 197 plus 66.8 in the Corporation line of Belle Center and which is the beginning point of this description; thence with the corporation line S. 8°-44' E., 152.6 feet to a point in the center of Liggett Lateral Ditch, passing a wooden hub at 119.9 feet; thence with the center of the Ditch S. 46° 0' W., 74.7 feet and S. 47° 28' W., 652.5 feet; thence N. 6° 24' W., 815.5 feet, passing an iron pin at 31.0 feet, to an iron pin in the center of S. H. 593 at Station 191 plus 48.4; thence with a 6° curve to the right, whose radius is 955.37 feet, 193.3 feet to an iron pin at Station 193 plus 41.7, which is the P.T. of the curve; thence S. 74°-44' E., 208.4 feet to an iron pin at Station 195 plus 50.1, which is the P.C. of the above 3° curve; thence with the said 3° curve to the right 216.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.70 acres.

An accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for its annexation and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto are on file with the Clerk of said Village, be and the same is hereby accepted.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
