## Surveyors Certificate.

The annexed plat represents Sub-division No one of the W.H. West Addition to the city of Bellefontaine Ohio and contains 14 lots numbered 2530 to 2543 inclusive, and three private alleys each 10 feet wide and the portions of the public alleys within the boundaries of this Sub-division on the East side of Main Street.





## Surveyors Certificate.

I, the undersigned Surveyor do hereby certify that the above plat is a correct representation of 57 lots together with the streets and alleys there with connected as surveyed and staked out on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> days of Sept. 1903, under the direction of Warren H. Outland et al. the owners of the premises situated in the middle part of the 8<sup>th</sup> or section 38 in Township and Range No 15 in Lake Township in the County of Logan and State of Ohio to be known and designated as "Belleville Addition" to the City of Bellefontaine, containing 17.36 acres. Main Street is on the Bellefontaine and West Liberty pike is 60 feet wide (or extends 30 feet east from the center of said pike) and bears S 5° W. Fair avenue is 50 feet wide (or extends 30 feet south from the North line of said Section), and bears S 84° 24' E. Pine and Spruce avenues are each 50 feet wide and together with the 10 alleys runs parallel with the said North line of the Section. 

The annexed plat represents Charles H. 




Map of Annexation of Territory






