Aiven's Addition to Bellefontaine, Ohio.

Surveyor Certificate. The above Plat is a correct representation of 32 Town Lots, together with the streets and Alleys thereon, represented, and also six other tracts of land marked on Plat "Sold" as surveyed and staked off by the undersigned Surveyor on the 19th & 20th days of June A.D. 1893, at the request and under the personal direction of J. Duncan McLaughlin, as Administrator with the Will Annexed of the Estate of David Aiven, deceased, being a part of the central part of the North West quarter of Section No. 54, Town No. 4th Range No. 14, in the County of Logan, and State of Ohio, and containing 8.⁶⁴ acres (independent of the said six other tracts of land marked on plat "Sold") in the name of said David Aiven, deceased. The bearings and lengths of the various lines are marked on the Plat, all being parallel with, or at right angles to Evansville Lym, and Patterson Streets, except the lines along and parallel with the railway ^{as} the lines running North ^{as} South from the East lines of Lots Nos. 8 & inclusive, East to Plum Valley Street, with which they are parallel. Evansville ^{as} Plum Valley Streets have been hent ^{as} located. 





Plat of Woolman & Knight Addition to Bellefontaine, Ohio.

Surveyor's Certificate. — I, the undersigned Surveyor, do hereby certify that the annexed plat is a true and correct representation of the Woolman & Knight Addition to the Incorporated Village of Bellefontaine, Ohio, as Surveyed, platted & laid out by me, under the direction of the Proprietors, Edwin C. Scarff, Joseph Horn, H. N. Lloyd, Jr., S. A. McColloch, Jonathan Parker, for Woolman & Knight in Sept. A.D. 1893. The lands laid out are a part of the S.E. 1/4 of Section No. 5, T. 3, R. 14 in R.S. of Harrison Twp. Logan Co., Ohio. Bounded & described as follows, North: Commencing at an iron pin corner on the South line of said Section West of the S.E. corner thereof 297 feet. Hence North 1018 feet with the center of St. Paris Street to an iron pin corner. Thence West with an angle of 91° 40' from the South 196.3 feet to an iron pin corner.
