thence with said Sullivan's line, S-56°18'31"-East, 330.00'(feet) to a railroad spike with cross-notch set on the centerline of aforementioned State Street, passing for reference an iron bar set on the right-of-way line of said State Street at 304.97'(feet);

thence with the centerline of said State Street, S-30°43'00"-W, 187.00'(feet) to the place of beginning.





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
