SURVEY FOR EICHOLTZ 0.560 Acre February 20, 2015

The following described 0.560 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Lake, City of Bellefontaine, Section 35, Town 4, Range 14, M.R.S., being all of Eicholtz, Inc.'s Lot 591 and Lot 592 of Powell Addition No. 2 filed in Plat Cabinet A, Slide 6, and being described in Deed Record 398, page 869, and said 0.560 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an 8 inch concrete post found in the west line of Main Street (80 feet wide), at the southeast corner of said Lot 592, and in the north line of a 16 ½ feet wide alley, said post marking the *place of beginning*;

Thence *North 85°32'44" West 220.81 feet*, following the south line of said Lot 592 and the north line of said 16 ½ feet wide alley, passing at 3.00 feet an iron pin set, to a magnetic nail set in the east line of a 16 ½ feet wide alley;

Thence *North 04°28'53" East 111.11 feet*, following the west line of said Lots 592 and 591 and following the east line of a 16 ½ feet wide alley, to a magnetic nail set at the southwest corner of Marjorie A. MacGillivray's west 55 feet of Lots 589 and 590 tract described in Official Record 188, page 955;

Thence *South 85°08'39" East 220.97 feet*, following the north line of said Lot 591, the south line of said west 55 feet of Lot 589 and Lot 590 tract, and following the south line of Marjorie A. MacGillivray's east part of Lots 589 and 590 tract described in Deed Record 383, page 343, passing at 218.97 feet an iron pin set, to an 8 inch concrete post found in the west line of Main Street;

Thence South 04°33'51" West 109.56 feet, following the west line of Main Street and the east line of said Lots 591 and 592 tract, to the place of beginning, containing 0.560 acre, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

The above description was prepared from a field survey made under the supervision of Paul R. Clapsaddle, Registered Surveyor #6140, during the January 2015. Bearings indicated herein are based on an assumed meridian with all others based on angles turned. Iron pins set are 5/8 inch by 30 inch reinforcing rods with caps marked "CLAPSADDLE RS #6140".
