Lying in the city of Bellefontaine, Section 33, T-4, R-14, Lake Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being the west part of the northerly 60 feet of that CON-RAIL abandoned railroad property as described in old Volume 95, Page 414 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron bolt found on the east line of South Main Street (U.S. Route 68) a distance of 303.46 feet, northerly, with said east street line, from an iron bolt found on the center-line of Richard Street.

THENCE, continuing with the said east line of Main Street, N 5°-00' E, a distance of 71.78 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set on the north right-of-way line of said abandoned railroad. This point also being the southwest corner of grantee's 3.59 acre tract (Volume 203, Page 197).

THENCE, with the said north right-of-way line and the south line of said 3.59 acre tract, and the south line of the D.A.B. 7.93 acres (Volume 203, Page 197, Tract I), on a curve to the left, having a radius of 2441.19 feet, a central angle of 18°-53'-42", and a length of 805.07 feet, the chord of which bears S 60°-41'-30" E, a distance of 801.41 feet to a 1" iron pipe found at the northeast corner of City Lot No. 3744, being the extreme east corner of a triangular tract containing 1496 square feet (Volume 230, Page 356-north part of Lots 3743 and 3744).

THENCE, through City Lots No. 3743 and 3744, N 85°-42'-00" W, a distance of 100.02 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set on the west line of Lot No. 3743.

THENCE, with the west line of Lot No. 3743, S 5°-20'-30" W, a distance of 32.66 feet to a 1"iron pipe found on the southeast corner of the railroad prop-

THENCE, on a curve to the right, parallel to and 60 feet southerly from the north line of this survey, having a radius of 2501.19 feet, a central angle of $15^{\circ}-57$ '-41" and a length of 696.77 feet, the chord of which bears N 60°-08'-17" W, a distance of 694.52 feet to the point of beginning.
