South line of Survey in Co. Road and Treaty Line

Surveyed as per above plat 100.88 A. of land for the Heirs of John Hughes. Find the East Line of said 100.88 A. well and plainly marked on several trees in a straight line. The west line also marked on several trees which vary to right and left of a direct line, some in the line. The most plainly marked being a large B.O. about midway and 12 links west of line. At corners 1, 2, 3, 4, planted stones in presence of Henry Hughes, Britton Morning, Edward Clark, A. McGinnis, William Perry, and Chain carrier Richard Price and Ephraim Scott.

 40 rods on S. line, instead of
 41 rods & that 45 yrs ago.

McSinnis now occupies on S line
 about 40³/₄ rods (W. fence crooked,
 no corners)

Amount in dispute not over 7 lks
 on S. line & gone on N. line,
 N 25 meas 50.50 ch.

McSinnis had set fence posts 1/2 rod
 to far east, even looking line west
 fence as on line.
