

THENCE, with the center-line of Township Road 123, S 79°-05'-49" E, a distance of 1343.99 feet to a railroad spike set at the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

THENCE, with the center-line of Township Road 123, S 79°-05'-49" E, a distance of 1379.63 feet to a 1/2 inch square iron rod found.


