Being a parcel of land situated in Virginia Military Survey 9890 Bokescreek Township, Logan County, Ohio, being part of the Geraldine Guider's original 37 acre tract, (parcel 1, tract 2), as described in O.R. vol. 287, pg. 875-882 in the Logan County Recorders Office and being further described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" rebar found at the intersection of the centerlines of T.R. 119 (40' in width) and State Route 292 (60' in width), said point being the southwest corner of the Geraldine Guider's original 37, acre tract, (parcel 1, tract 2), (O.R. Vol. 287, pg. 875-882):

(1) Thence N. 22°-45'-00" E., along the centerline of State Route 292, (60' in width), for 1193.65 feet to a railroad spike found-

(2) Thence S. 79°-54'-00" E., along the south line of Dale F. Coleman's 10.002 acre tract, (O.R. Vol. 210, pg. 778), for 1028.66 feet to a 1/2" iron pipe found, passing a 1/2" iron pipe found at 25.62 feet-

(3) Thence S. 06°-09'-16" E., along the east line of V.M.S. 9890 and the west line of Bernard Bates 56.66 acre tract, (D.B. Vol. 350, pg. 864), for 756.44 feet to a 1" rebar found on the centerline of T.R. 119 (40' in width)-

(4) Thence S. 84°-05'-00" W., along said centerline, for 1589.10 feet to the point of beginning. Containing in all 27.891 acres of land, 1.415 acres lying within the right of way of T.R. 119 (40' in width) and State Route 292, (60' in width), subject however to all legal easements and rights of way.


INDEXED ON MAP

Being a parcel of land situated in Virginia Military Survey 9890 and 9891 Bokescreek Township, Logan County, Ohio, being part of the Geraldine Guider's 58.513 acre tract (parcel 5) and original 70.56 acre (parcel 1, tract 1), 128.936 acres, as described in O.R. Vol. 287, pg. 875-882, in the Logan County Recorders Office and being further described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a P.K. nail found at the intersection of the centerlines of State Route 292 (60' in width) and C.H. 20 (40' in width), said point referenced to a survey indexed on map 2776 and filed in the Logan County Tax Map Office. Thence N. 83°-06'-00" E., along the centerline of C.H. 20 (40' in width), for 155.40 feet to a railroad spike found at the northeast corner of Raymond C. Amspaugh etux, 1.49 acre tract, (O.R. Vol. 220, pg. 347), this point being the point of beginning for the parcel to be described;

- (1) Thence from this point of beginning N. 83^o22'-10" E., along the centerline of C.H. 20 (40' in width), for 2065.50 feet to a railroad spike set-
- (2) Thence S. 06°-56'-53" E., along the west line of Helen V. Terrill's 109.370 acre tract, (D.B. Vol. 361, pg. 476) and along a line of Robert E. Culp's 27.92 acre tract, (D.B. Vol. 390, pg. 500), survey indexed on map 6574 in the Logan County Tax Map Office, for 2095.60 feet to a 1/2" by 30" rebar with plasticap marked "T.C.H. 5044" set-
- (3) Thence S. 83°-18'-57" W., along a line of the Robert E. Culp tract and the north lines of the Than Artis's 9.72 acre tract, (O.R. Vol. 116, pg. 37) and Bernard Bates 57.34 acre tract, (D.B. Vol. 350, pg. 864), for 2503.52 feet to a 1/2" iron pipe found-
- (4) Thence N. 79°-54'-00" W., along the north line of Dale F. Coleman's 10.002 acre tract, (O.R. Vol. 210, pg. 778), survey indexed on map 8854 in the Logan County Tax Map Office, for 812.93 feet to a railroad spike found on the centerline of State Route 292, passing at 778.83 feet a 1/2" iron pipe found-
- (5) Thence N. 22^o-46'-14" E., along the centerline of State Route 292, (60' in width), for 1537.67 feet to a railroad spike found-
- (6) Thence N. 84°-22'-00" E., along the south line of Raymond C. Amspaugh's 1.9966 acre tract, (O.R. Vol. 248, pg. 354), survey indexed on map 2776 in the Logan County Tax Map Office, for 417.64 feet to a 5/8" iron pin found, passing at 34.10 feet a 5/8" iron pin found-
- (7) Thence N. 03°-08'-00" W., along the east line of the Raymond C. Amspaugh's 1.9966 acre tract and the 1.49 acre tract, for 532.50 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing in all 129.677 acres surveyed, 115.297 acres in V.M.S. 9891 and 14.380 acres in V.M.S. 9890 of land, 0.954 acres lying within the right of way of C.H. 20 and St. Rt 292 in V.M.S. 9891 and 1.059 acres lying within the right of way of St. Rt 292 in V.M.S. 9890, subject however to all legal easements and rights of way.



Being a parcel of land situated in Virginia Military Survey 9938, Bokescreek Creek Township, Logan County, Ohio, being part of the Geraldine Guider's 35.18 acre and 40.26 acre tracts, as described in O.R. Vol. 287, pg. 875-882, in the Logan County Recorders Office and being further described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found at the intersection of the centerlines of State Route 292 (60' in width) and CH- 48, this point being on the south line of V.M.S. 9938-

(1) Thence from this point of beginning, S. 84°-41'-00" W., along the south line of V.M.S. 9938 and the north line of Robert D. Ford's 5.17 acre tract (D.B. Vol. 330, pg. 646) and the north line of Newton W. Ramsey's 312.18 acre tract, (D.B. Vol. 344, pg. 314), for a distance of 2549.99 feet to a 3" steel post found-

- (5) N. 84^o-17'-53" E. for 762.73 feet to a 3/4" square iron pin found-

Thence along the lines of Anderson & Sons Investment Corp., 19.00 acre tract, (D.B. Vol. 392, pg. 279, with the following two courses-



GUIDER TO COLEMAN SURVEY

The following described real estate situated in the Township of Bokescreek, County of Logan, State of Ohio and being a part of Virginia Military Survey No. 9890 and being a part of an original 37.00 Acre tract and a 14.69 Acre tract in the name of Meredith A. and Geraldine H. Guider, H/W. as recorded in Official Record No. 169 Page 714 (8-21-1992) and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a 5/8 inch Rebar found at the intersection of the centerlines of T. R. No. 119 and S. R. No. 292 and being the southwest corner to said 37.00 Acre tract;

Thence with the centerline of S. R. No. 292, N. 22°45'00" E. 1,193.65 feet to a R. R. Spike set for the true place of begginning, (Note: The centerline of S. R. No. 292 is the Basis of Bearing for this survey - N. 22°45'00" E.);

Thence continuing with the centerline of S. R. No. 292, N. 22°45'00" E. 478.10 feet to a R. R. Spike set, passing the northwest corner to said 37.00 Acre tract at 463.10 feet;

Thence S. 79°54'00" E. 813.57 feet to a 1/2" x 30" Iron Pipe set next to a Wood Corner Post found at the northeast corner to said 37.00 Acre tract and the southeast corner to a 14.69 Acre tract and being in the east line of said V.M.S. No. 9890, passing through a 1/2" x 30" Iron Pipe set at 25.62 feet;

Thence with the east line of said V.M.S. No. 9890, S. 6°09'16" E. 485.92 feet to a 1/2" x 30" Iron Pipe set;

Thence N. $79^{\circ}54'00"$ W. 1,054.28 feet to the true place of beginning, passing through a 1/2" x 30" Iron Pipe set at 1,028.66 feet, containing a total of 435,676.0125 square feet or 10.002 Acres, more or less.

Of the above described tract, there is 5,972.385 square feet or 0.137 Acres out of the present 14.69 Acre tract and 429,723.6275 square feet or 9.865 Acres out of a 37.756 Acre tract (originally 37.00 Acres).

There is also 11,952.50 square feet or 0.274 Acres in the right of way of S. R. No. 292.
