

MICHAEL E. STALEY SURVEY 0.098 ACRE December 13, 2007

The following described 0.098 acre tract of land is situated in the Village of Degraff, Miami Township, Logan County, Ohio and being all of Michael E. and Cathy A. Beginning at a point at the southeast corner of a brick building and at the southeast corner of said Lot 33, said building corner also at the intersection of the west line of Main Street (60 feet wide) with the north line of a 16 feet wide public alley running in a westerly direction, said building corner also being the southeast corner of said Staley's Tract I;


Thence South 61°32'34" West 134.78 feet, departing from the west line of Main Street and the south line of said brick building, following the south line of said Lot 33, the south line of said Staley's Tract I, and the north line of said 16 feet wide public alley running in a westerly direction, to a point in the east line of a 16 feet wide alley running in a northerly direction;




