Foundry Street

Surveyed March 12th 1849 an addition to the town of East Liberty for Daniel McClain and George Robinson as follows Beginning at the point marked "Stone" in the foregoing plat at the junction of "Foundry Street" and "West Alley" thence N 37° W. to the point "A." thence S 53° W. to the point "B." thence S 37° E. to the point "O" thence N 53° E. to the place of Beginning. Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 are each 60 feet front on Temperance Street and extend 224 feet

back containing 13,440 square feet,  
"First" Second Third and fourth alleys  
are each 16 feet wide

West alley is 32 feet wide and Apple  
alley is 20 feet wide

Temperance and Foundry Streets are
