HUNTSVILLE LAND BANK (0.534 ACRE)

Lying in the Village of Huntsville, Virginia Military Survey 9904, McArthur Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being all of the Huntsville Land Bank, Inc., an Ohio corporation, properties as described in Volume 333, Page 544 and Volume 333, Page 547 of the Logan County records of Deeds and subject to Logan County Common Pleas Court Case CIV 89-05.0074 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron rod set on the south right-of-way of Napoleon Street. Said iron rod is S 73°-24'-55" E, a distance of 125.69 feet from the intersection of the south right-of-way of Napoleon Street and the east right-of-way of Lima Street (Lima Street is also known as State Route 117).

THENCE, with the south right-of-way of Napoleon Street, S 73°-24'-55" E, a distance of 131.06 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, with the west line of the Harold Snapp 1.295 acre tract (O.R. 73, Page 576), S 15°-24'-00" W, a distance of 204.95 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, with the north line of the Douglas Schaub 0.55 acre tract (O.R. 82, Pg. 831), S 86°-54'-17" W, a distance of 90.01 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, with the east lines of the said 0.55 acre tract and the Kevin Allison 0.25 acre tract (O.R. 91, Pg. 380), N 15°-35'-24" E, a distance of 135.25 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, N 73°-24'-55" W, a distance of 3.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, N 15°-35'-24" E, a distance of 2.50 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the north line of the aforesaid 0.25 acre tract, N 80°-22'-41" W, a distance of 41.84 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set at the southeast corner of the Robert Jenkins 0.09 acre tract (O.R. 43, Pg. 34).

THENCE, with the east line of the said 0.09 acre tract, N 14°-33'-44" E, a distance of 102.63 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 0.534 acre.

The basis for bearings is based upon the south line of Napoleon Street being S 73°-24'-55" E, and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey performed by Lee Surveying and Mapping Company on February 4, 1991.

Reserving however, a 5.00 foot wide strip of land immediately east of the west line of the previously described 0.534 acre tract adjoining the Robert P. Jenkins 0.09 acre tract (O.R. 43, Pg. 34) for purposes of a common right-of-way.

SAVE AND EXCEPT the second story of the structure located on said premises and stairway leading thereto. (See Logan County Common Pleas Court Case CIV 89-05.0074).



HUNTSVILLE BANK SURVEY

Lying in the Village of Huntsville, V.M.S. 9904, McArthur Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being a survey encompassing 3 tracts of land lying in the name of Huntsville Land Bank, Incorporated (Volume 330, Page 318; Volume 330, Page 443 and Volume 330, Page 809 of the Logan County Records of Deeds). Being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a chiseled '+' in concrete marking the intersection of the east line of Lima Street with the south line of Napoleon Street.

THENCE, with the said south line of Napoleon Street, S 71°-32' E, a distance of 90.40 feet to a 1" iron pipe found at the south edge of the concrete sidewalk at the northeast corner of that lot described in aforementioned Volume 330, Page 318.

THENCE, with the east line of said lot, S 19°-21'-10" W, a distance of 83.29 feet to an iron rod set on the east line of that 0.11 acre lot (Volume 330, Page 443).

THENCE, with said east line, S 4°-02' E, a distance of 27.41 feet to a 2" iron pipe found marking the southeast corner of said 0.11 acre lot.

THENCE, with the south line of said 0.11 acre lot, N 86°-23'-20" W, 42.75 feet to a 1" iron pipe found at the east edge of the east sidewalk of Lima Street marking the southwest corner of said 0.11 acre lot.

THENCE, with the said east edge of sidewalk, N 7°-20' W, a distance of 132.80 feet to the point of beginning.



LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR JACK REPROGLE'S 0.251 ACRE TRACT

Being situate in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of McArthur, Village of Huntsville, and being a part of Virginia Military Survey 9904, and being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning for reference at a P.K. Nail set at the intersection of the centerlines of Napoleon Street (60' right-ofway) and Lima Street, a.k.a. State Route 117 (60' right-of-way);

thence with the centerline of said Lima Street, S-9 0 31'41"-E, 177.23'(feet) to a P.K. Nail set at the PRINCIPLE PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract hereinafter described:

thence with the South line of a 0.166 acre tract owned by Robert Jenkins as recorded in Official Record 128, page 559, N-87°28'47"-E, 68.39'(feet) to a 2" diameter iron pipe found at grade, passing for reference an iron bar set on the right-of-way line of Lima Street at 30.23'(feet);

thence with the South line of a 0.09 acre tract also owned by Robert Jenkins as recorded in Official Record 128, page 563, and with a line of a 0.534 acre tract owned by Provico Inc. as recorded in Official Record 122, page 731, S-80°21'18"-E, 76.86'(feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar found, at grade, with a "LEE" I.D. cap, passing for reference a 5/8" diameter iron bar found, at grade, with a "LEE" I.D. cap at the Southeast corner of aforementioned Jenkins' 0.09 acre tract, at 35.02'(feet);

thence with the bounds of said Provico Inc.'s tract the following three (3) courses;

(1) S-15°45'20"-W, 2.50'(feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar found, at grade with a "LEE" I.D. cap;
(2) S-73°28'25"-E, 3.00'(feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar found,

at grade, with a "LEE" I.D. cap;

(3) $S-15^{\circ}36'21"-W$, 76.02'(feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar found, 0.1' below grade, with a "CLAPSADDLE" I.D. cap, at a Northeast corner of a 0.55 acre tract owned by Douglas Schaub as recorded in Official Record 82, page 831;

thence with the North line of said Schaub's tract, N-88°34'50"-W, 111.85'(feet) to a P.K. Nail set on the centerline of aforementioned Lima Street, passing for reference a 5/8" diameter iron bar found, at grade, on the right-of-way line of said Lima Street, at 81.29'(feet);

thence with the centerline of said Lima Street, N-9031'41"-W, 84.74'(feet) to the place of beginning.

Being a more accurate description of the same premises conveyed to Jack Reprogle by Deed recorded in Official Record 219, page 540 of the Logan County records.



All other bearings are per distances measured and angles observed in the field.
