THENCE, with the north line of the Walter L. Lamb, Jr. original 71.17 acre tract (Volume 362, Page 860), S 83°-40'-02" W, a distance of 640.18 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set, passing a concrete right-of-way monument found at 30.02 feet.

THENCE, N 6°-41'-50" W, a distance of 50.00 feet to a 3/4 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, with the south line of the Paul E. Bradley 5.83 acre tract (Vol. 325, Pg. 43), N 83°-41'-01" E, a distance of 642.56 feet to the point of beginning, passing a 3/4 inch iron rod found at 612.54 feet.

Containing 0.735 acre, of which 0.034 acre is within the highway right-of-way.




