



Property is subject to any and all previous easements and rights-of-way of record.

Bearings and distances, described herein, are derived from GPS observations based on Grid North, Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, North Zone, NAD83 (2011, Epoch 2010), with the centerline of County Highway 153 having a bearing of South 76°-17'-49 East. Distances are expressed in U.S. Survey Feet. All other measurements are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by DLZ on June 25, 2020.
