The 1st lot begins at 2 white Oaks
 corner to George M^{rs} Collock in the east line
 Th^o. M. Barley's Survey N^o 5864: - thence
 with said line Crig. course called south
 104 poles, crossing a branch at 40 poles to
 2 Red Oaks from end root; thence S 88^o E
 33^{1/2} poles, to 2 Dogwood & Hickory (the
 Hickory is down) N.W. Corner to Henry Foust
 thence North 127^{1/2} poles crossing a branch to
 2 white Oaks thence S 69^o, 37' W 44 poles
 to the beginning - Containing 25 1/4 acres.

The 2nd Lot begins at 2 Red
 Oaks from end root N.W. Corner to
 the lot N^o 1 in the east line of
 Th^o. M. Barley's Survey N^o 5864: thence

with said line South 104 poles, to 3 Black Oak (down) his
