ANNEXATION PLAT

TO THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE, OHIO

Beginning at a point on the Easterly right-of-way line of the General Railroad (originally C.C. & St. L. R.R.) right-of-way line, Station 7343+84.10, said point of beginning also being on the westerly Corporation Line of the City of Bellefontaine;

thence N. 68° 59' W. a distance of 410 feet to a point in the westerly right-of-way line of Conrail Railroad, said point being 150 feet N. of survey Station 7343+84.10;

thence N. 21° 01' E. a distance of 3875.5 feet along the westerly right-of-way line of Conrail Railroad, passing the line between V.M.S. 2873 and 3317 at a distance of 2409.52 feet more or less;

thence N. 84° 29' E. a distance of 52.5 feet to a point which is 120 feet westerly of the original railroad centerline of survey;
