to a Stone & NW corner to George Marquis. There with  
his South line S 89° E 58° pole ending a run of 304 poles  
to a Stone. Chipping Sassafras in John Marquis' West line and  
S. E. corner to said Kuykendall. Then S 2° E 53° pole to a Willow  
corner to Marquis; there S 88° E 17° pole to a stone & N 1/2 E.  
Then corner to Mortimer Survey N<sup>o</sup> 4498. There with his
