## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

## STORM SEWER EASEMENT #1

BEING A PERPETUAL STORM SEWER EASEMENT 15.00 FEET IN WIDTH OVER, ACROSS, AND THROUGH A 3.290-ACRE TRACT OF LAND OWNED BY CLAUDE E. thence, South 06°-03'-01" West, 15.00 feet, along the west line of said 3.890 acre tract to a point on the northerly right-of-way line of said Grove Street;

thence, North 83°-56'-59" West, 329.95 feet, along the northerly right-of-way line of said Grove Street to the principal place of beginning.

Containing 9149.24 square feet more or less or 0.210 acres more or less with all being subject to any legal highways and easements of record.


