Stutzman's 37.16 acre tract and said point also being station 209 plus 97 of State Highway number 189 as shown on Logan County Engineer's plan M-40 page 55 thence with the North line of said Stutzman tract N. 87 - 22 W. 602.28 feet to a stake the last described line passing a stone at the West side of State Highway Number 189 at 40.28 feet (Being 40.00 feet when measured at right angles) and also crossing the center of McKees Creek at 580 feet thence with the present fence line N. 3 - 47 E. 79.46 feet to a pipe thence S. 87 - 22 E. 591.28 feet to the center of State Highway number 189 the last described line passing the center of McKees Creek at 71 feet and passing the West side of said State Highway at 551.00 feet thence with the center of State Highway Number 189 S. 4 - 10 E. 80.00 feet to the place of beginning said tract containing 1.09 acres.
