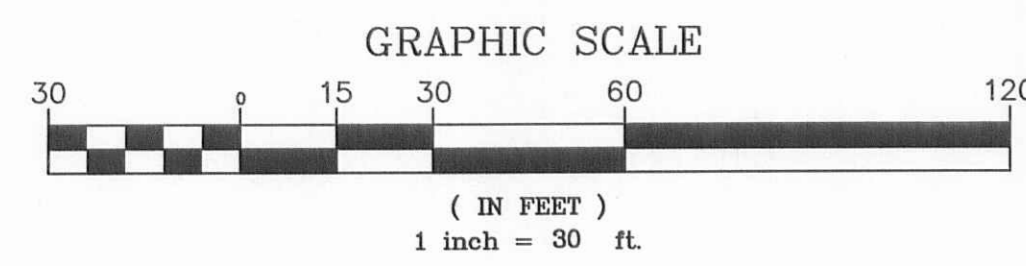


LOCATION MAP

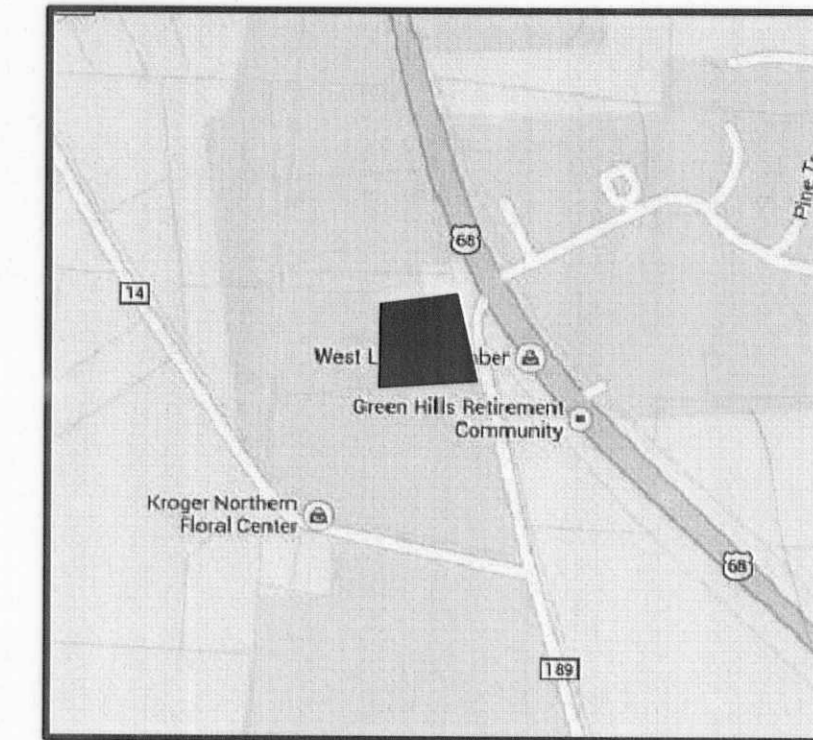

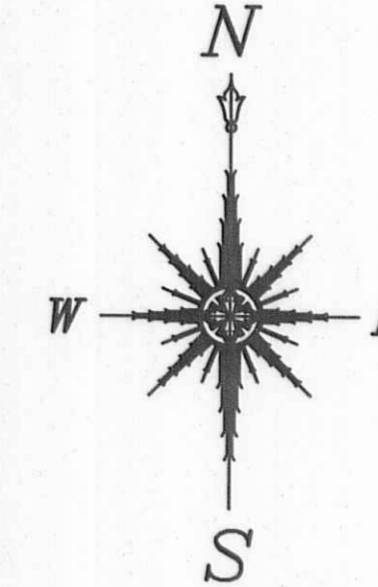

LOCATION MAP

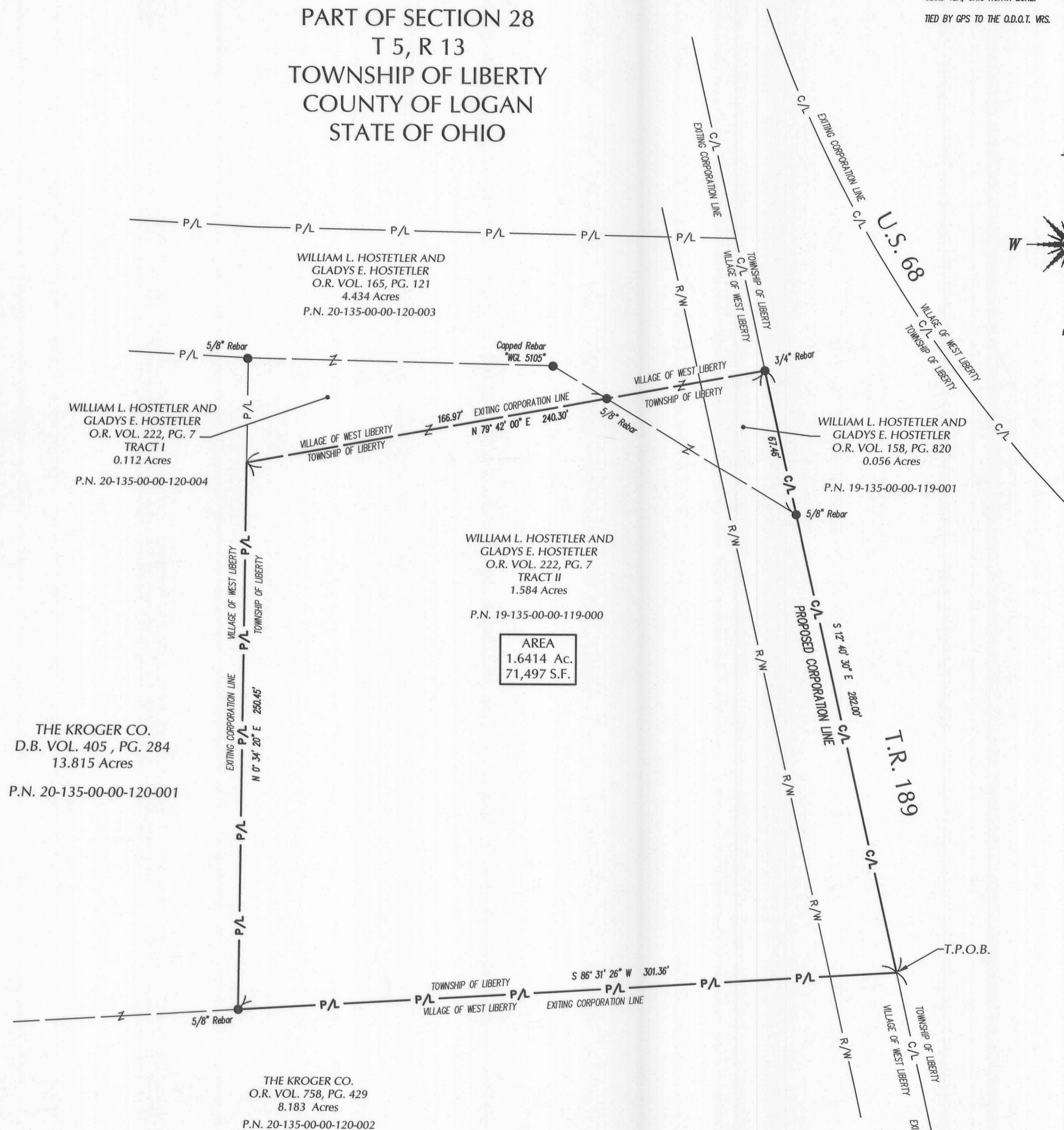
