

Surveyed on the 30th day of January
 A. D. 1858 for Christian Uoder, a part
 of the South West Quarter of Section
 No. 25, of Town No. 4, & Range No. 14, E. T. H. S.
 Beginning at a stone in the North line
 of the said S. W. quarter from which a
 White Oak bush 2 inches in diam bears S. $18\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W. $3\frac{3}{4}$ links; & a Black Oak, 30 inches diam bears
 S 40 E. 28 links, thence with said North line
 of the quarter N. $88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 17.25 chains to a stone
 N. E. corner to Samuel Covington's land;
 Thence S. $1\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 17.57 chains to a stone,
 Samuel Covington's S. E. corner; Thence N.
 89° W. 5.49 chains to a stake; Thence S
 $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 24.21 chains to a stake in the South
 line of the Section 14.40 chains East from
 the S. W. section corner; Thence with the
 said South line of the section S. $88\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E.
 22.87 chains to a stone, from which a
 White Oak 25 ^{in.} in diam. bears S. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 5.8 links
 Thence North 1° East 41.89 chains to the
 place of beginning; containing Eighty
 five ^{acres} (85.89) & Eighty hundredths of an acre
