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J. ROBERT RENICK 1.914 ACRES

Lying in Virginia Military Survey 9903-9928, McArthur Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being out of the J. Robert Renick and Marilyn Renick original 169.24 acre tract as deeded and described in Official Record 276, Page 342 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found at the intersection of center-lines of County Highway 37 and Township Road 56.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 37 (60 feet wide), S 83°-40'-00" W, a distance of 393.45 feet to a railroad spike set.

THENCE, N 6°-20'-00" W, a distance of 30.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set on the right-of-way of County Highway 37.

THENCE, N 37°-30'-10" E, a distance of 397.87 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set on the bank of Cherokee Mann's Creek.

THENCE, N 58°-31'-00" E, a distance of 33.50 feet to a point in the middle of the said creek.


THENCE, with the center-line of the creek and the westerly lines of the James Mast original 100 acre tract (O.R. 114, Pg. 276) and the Timothy Irwin 10.89 acre tract (O.R. 163, Pg. 786), S 31°-29'-00" E, a distance of 365.92 feet to a MAG nail set.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 37, S 83°-40'-00" W, a distance of 67.95 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 1.914 acre of which 0.313 acre is within the highway right-of-way.

The basis for bearings is the center-line of County Highway 37 being S 83°-40'-00" W, and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by Lee Surveying and Mapping Co., Inc. on May 16, 1996.

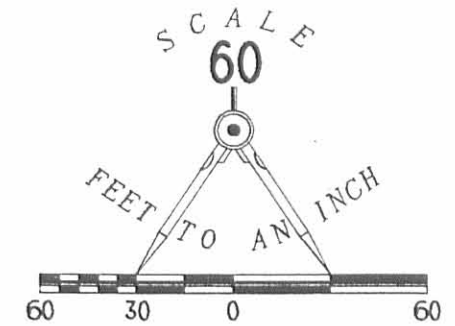

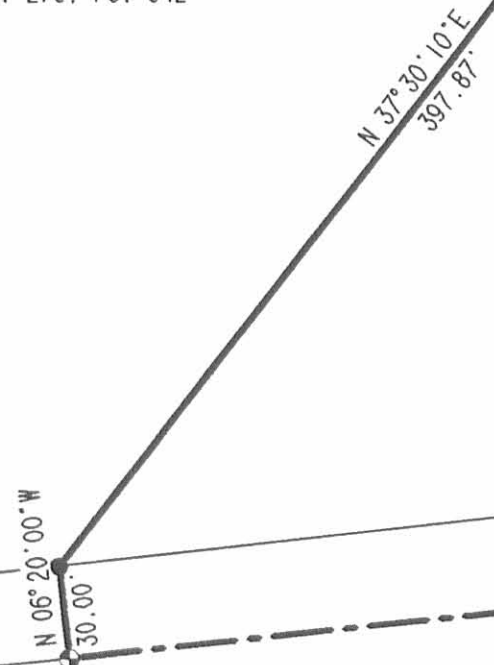

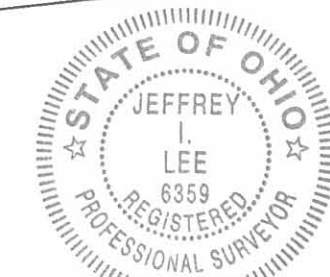

Beginning at an iron in the center of County Road Number 37 known as the Huntsville - Lewistown Road and at the S.W. corner of said Survey 9903 9928 thence with the west side of County Road Number 99 which is also the west side of V.M.S. 9903 9928 N. 7 - 00 W. 3880.0 feet to an iron the last described line passing the N.E. corner of Robert E. Jenkins 30.69 acre tract at 984.0 feet and also passing the N.E. corner of Wilbur A. S. 7 - 54 E. 303.7 feet to a square wood post

S. 3 - 49 W. 47.0 feet to a square wood post

S. 9 - 29 E. 1761.5 feet to a large concrete post at the S.W. corner of the Fry 101.23 acre tract

S. 31 - 29 E. 722.5 feet to the center of said County Road Number 37 and being station 193 plus 36.4 as shown in Logan County Engineer's Book 577 page 27

thence with the center of said Road Number 37 which is also the south line of V.M.S. 9903 9928

S. 83 - 40 W. 3487.0 feet to the place of beginning which is station 158 plus 49.4 as shown in Logan County Engineer's Book 577 page 37 the last described line passing an iron in the center of County Road Number 99 at 3472.0 feet

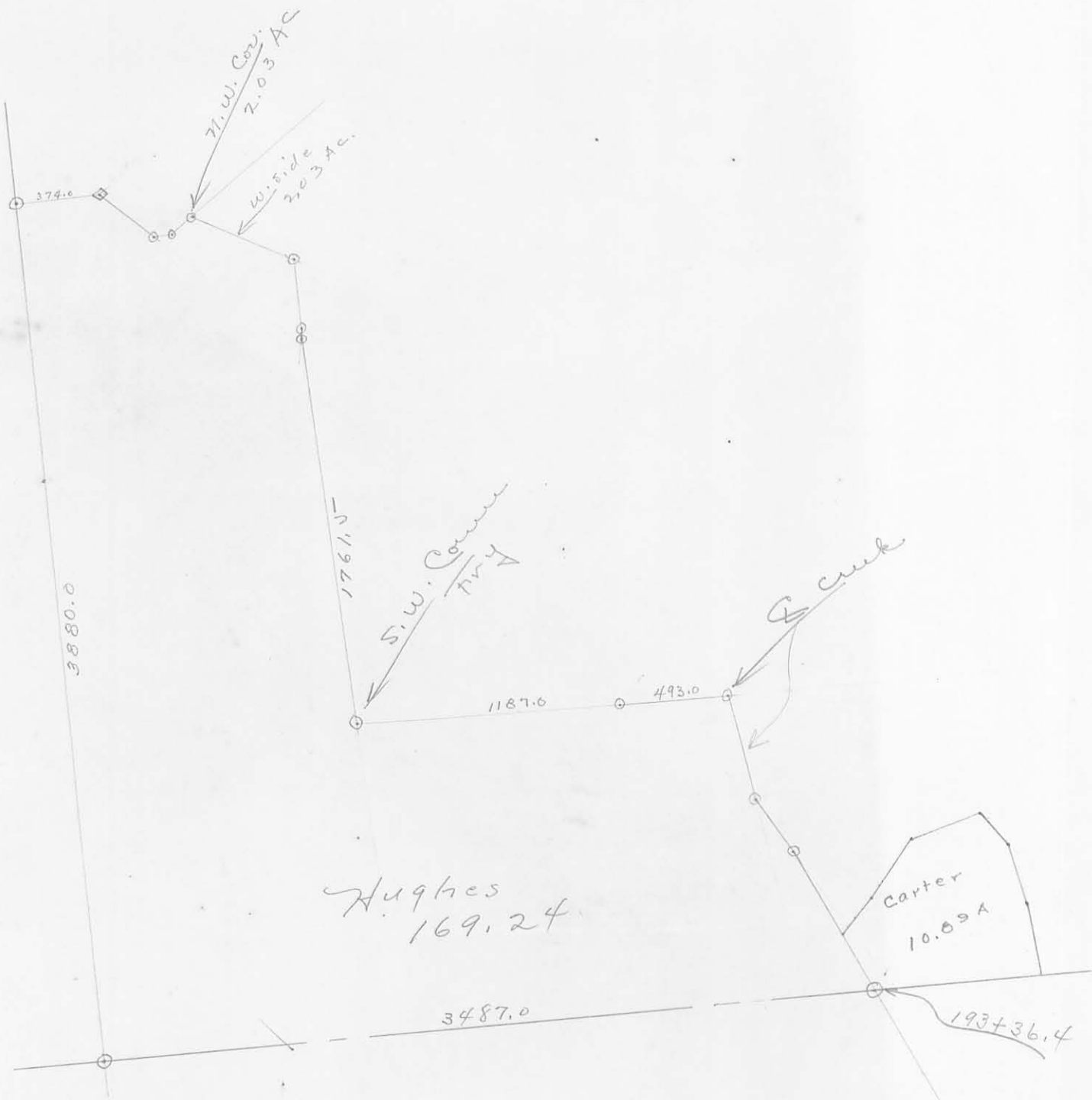
