

Tract No. 1- Being a part of Sections 29, 30 and 35, Township 3, Range 13 being Tract No. 6, as shown on the recorded plat of E. S. Baughman's land on page 25, Vol. D of the Records and Surveys in the County Surveyor's office, Bellefontaine, Ohio, and bounded and described as follows Commencing at a stake at Miami River in the West line of Section No. 30 from which a 30-inch beech bears South 4 3/4 deg. West 1.66 chains distant: thence with said Section line South 4-3/4 deg. West (passing said beach at 1.66 chains 36.37 chains to a stake at the Southwest corner of said section No. 30; thence with the North line of section 35 North 85 1/4 deg. West 15.50 chains to a stone at the Northeast corner of David Heath's land; thence with said Heath's East line, South 42 deg. West crossing the center of the DeGraff and Quincy free turnpike at 13.95 chains, and continuing same course (South 42 deg. West) with the east line of A. F. DeWeese's land 16.83 chains to an iron bolt in the center of the C. C. & St. L. Railroad; the total length of 1998.48 this line being 30.28 chains; thence with the center of said railroad South 851 deg. West 7.34 chains to an iron bolt; thence with the East line of Lewis T. Haines' land South 4 3/4 deg. West 6.98 chains to an anchor post, passing a stone in the South line of the railroad right of way at 76 links; thence South 87 deg. East 22.69 chains to a stone in the Northwest corner of Hattie L. Stephenson's land (passing a stone at the Northwest corner of Anna Slagel's land at 64 links) and passing a stone at the Northwest corner of Belle Doran's land at 11.65 chains; thence with the North line of said Stephenson's land, South 85 3/4 deg. East 11.24 chains to a stone; thence North $4\frac{1}{8}$ deg. East 72.26 chains to the Miami River (passing an iron bar in the center of said railroad at 11.68 chains) passing an iron bar in the center of the aforesaid pike at 23.59 chains) and passing a stone at 71.52 chains from which an 18 inch sugar bears North 25 deg. East 51 links distant and a 22 inck black walnut bears Touth 251 deg. Hast 80 links distant thence Northwesterly with said river to the place of beginning, containing 144.12 acres of which 41.76 acres are in Section 29; 38.22 acres in Section 30 and 64.14 acres in Section 35.

Commencing at a stone in the South line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 29, 3.55 chains west from the West line of J. G. Wilkinson's 4906.50 land; thence North 42 deg. East 75.25 chains to the Miami River (passing an iron bar in the South line of the right of way of the C.C.C.& St. L. Railroad at 11.40 chains) (passing an iron bar in the center of the DeGraff and Quincy Free Turnpike at 22.69 chains) and passing a stone in line at 74.56 chains, from which a 26 inch sycamore bears North 212 deg. East 84 links distant and a 17 inch white elm bears North 22 deg. West 68 links distant: thence Southwesterly with said River to a stake 5.43 chains distant at right angles from the line last above described: thence South 42 deg. West 72.26 chains to a stone in the South line of the said Northwest Quarter as said Section No. 29 (passing a stone in line at 7.4 links from which an 18 inch sugar bears North 25 deg. East 51 links distant and a 22 inch black walnut bears South 25 deg. East 80 links distant (passing an iron in the center of the aforesaid pike at 48.67 chains) passing an iron bar in the center of the above mentioned railroad at 60.58 chains; thence with said South line South 85 3/4 deg. East 5.42 chains to the place of beginning, containing 40 acres of land of which 20.43 acres are in Section 29, and 19.57 acres are in Section 30. Containing in all 184.12 acres, more or less. LISA A. BAMBAUER SURVEY 22.952 ACRES May 29, 2002

The following described 22.952 acre tract of land is situated in Sections 29 and 30, Town 3, Range 13, Miami Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of Lisa A. Bambauer and M. Ogreta Bambauer's Tract No. 1, originally 144.12 acres, and Tract No. 2, originally 40.0 acres, described in Official Record 198, page 443, said 22.952 acre tract more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron pin found at the intersection of the centerline of County Road 70 (60 feet wide) with the east line of said original 40.0 acre tract and the west line of Ronald K. and Marguerite Bell's 60.514 acre tract described in Official Record 547, page 617;

Thence North 76°25'01" West 594.17 feet, following the centerline of County Road 70, crossing said original 40.0 acre tract and entering said original 144.12 acre tract, passing a 5/8 inch iron pin found at 362.66 feet, to a railroad spike set;

Thence **North 4°30'00" East 1656.29 feet**, departing from the centerline of County Road 70, passing an iron pin set at 30.19 feet, leaving said Section 29 and entering said Section 30, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 85°30'00" East 586.72 feet, leaving said original 144.12 acre tract and crossing said original 40.0 acre tract, to an iron pin set in the west line of said 60.514 acre tract;

Thence South 4°30'00" West 179.67 feet, following the east line of said original 40.0 acre tract and the west line of said 60.514 acre tract, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found at the northwest corner of Ronald K. and Marguerite Bell's 5.22 acre tract described in Deed Volume 333, page 494;

Thence South 4°26'45" West 661.06 feet, following the east line of said original 40.0 acre tract and the west line of said 5.22 acre tract, leaving said Section 30 and entering said Section 29, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found at an angle point in the west line of said 60.514 acre tract;

Thence South 4°32'22" West 909.36 feet, following the east line of said original 40.0 acre tract and the west line of said 60.514 acre tract, passing an iron pin set at 878.98 feet, to the place of beginning, containing 22.952 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above described 22.952 acre tract, 0.408 acre is within the road right-of-way of County Road 70, 10.255 acres are within said Section 30, of which 4.001 acres are part of said original 144.12 acre tract and 6.254 acres are part of said original 40.0 acre tract, and 12.697 acres are within said Section 29, of which 4.787 acres are part of said original 144.12 acre tract and 7.910 acres are part of said original 40.0 acre tract.

The above description was prepared from an actual field survey made by George A. Blackburn, Registered Surveyor #7873, during the month of May 2002. Iron pins set are 5/8 inch by 30 inch reinforcing rods with plastic caps marked "Blackburn RS #7873." Bearings indicated herein are based on the centerline of County Road 70 (60 feet wide) being North 76°25'01" West.


