<sup>8600</sup> Surveyed a small lot of land  
for Mr. Campbell as follows beginning at a  
stake in the east edge of the Mad River  
and Lake Erie Rail Road Territory and  
in the south line of the lands owned  
by George Hover late of Logan County  
known as being part of Military Survey No.  
9903 on the waters of the Great Miami  
hence  $S 13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 10.4$  poles to a stake in  
the east edge of the aforesaid Rail Road  
and also in the east edge of the Line  
Road thence  $S 11^{\circ} E 9.3$  poles to a stake  
thence  $S 86\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 13$  poles to a stake
