Thence South 30°08'20" East (assumed bearing) 438.17 feet, following the centerline of Township Road #166, to a ¾" iron pin found at Station 67 + 75;

Thence South 22°11'58" East 206.87 feet, continuing along the centerline of Township Road #166 and following the west line of said 43 acre tract, to a railroad spike set and marking the place of beginning;

Thence **North 74°50'16"** East 239.95 feet, departing from the centerline of Township Road #166 and entering said 43 acre tract, passing at 20.15 feet an iron pin set; to an iron pin set;

Thence South 74°50'16" West 239.95 feet, following the north line of said 83 acre tract and the south line of said 43 acre tract, passing at 219.89 feet a 3/8" iron pin



found, to a 2" iron axle found in the centerline of Township Road #166 at Station 50 + 80.8;

Thence North 22°11'58" West 200.00 feet, following the centerline of Township Road #166 and the west line of said 43 acre tract, to the place of beginning, containing 1.093 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above described 1.093 acre tract, 0.092 acres are within the road right of way of Township Road #166.
