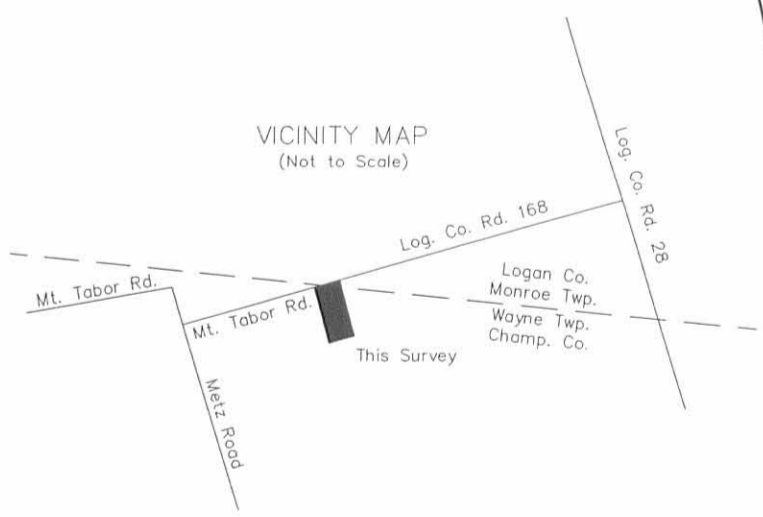

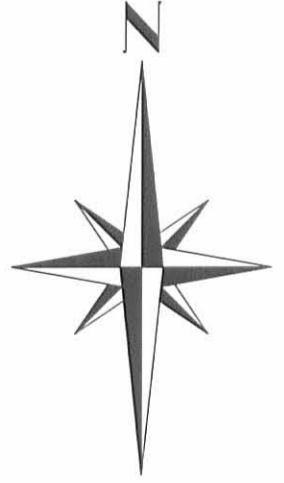

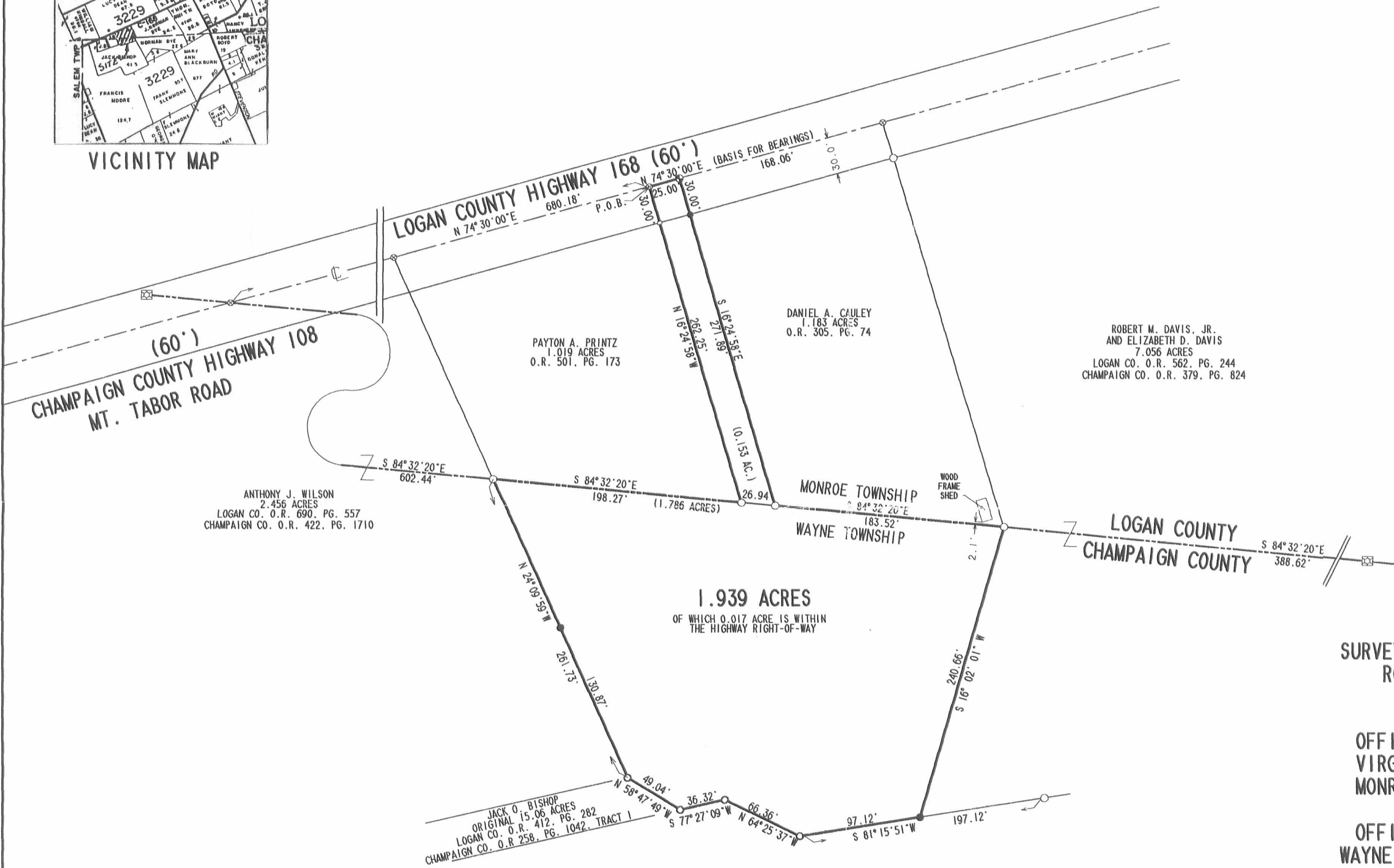


VICINITY MAP

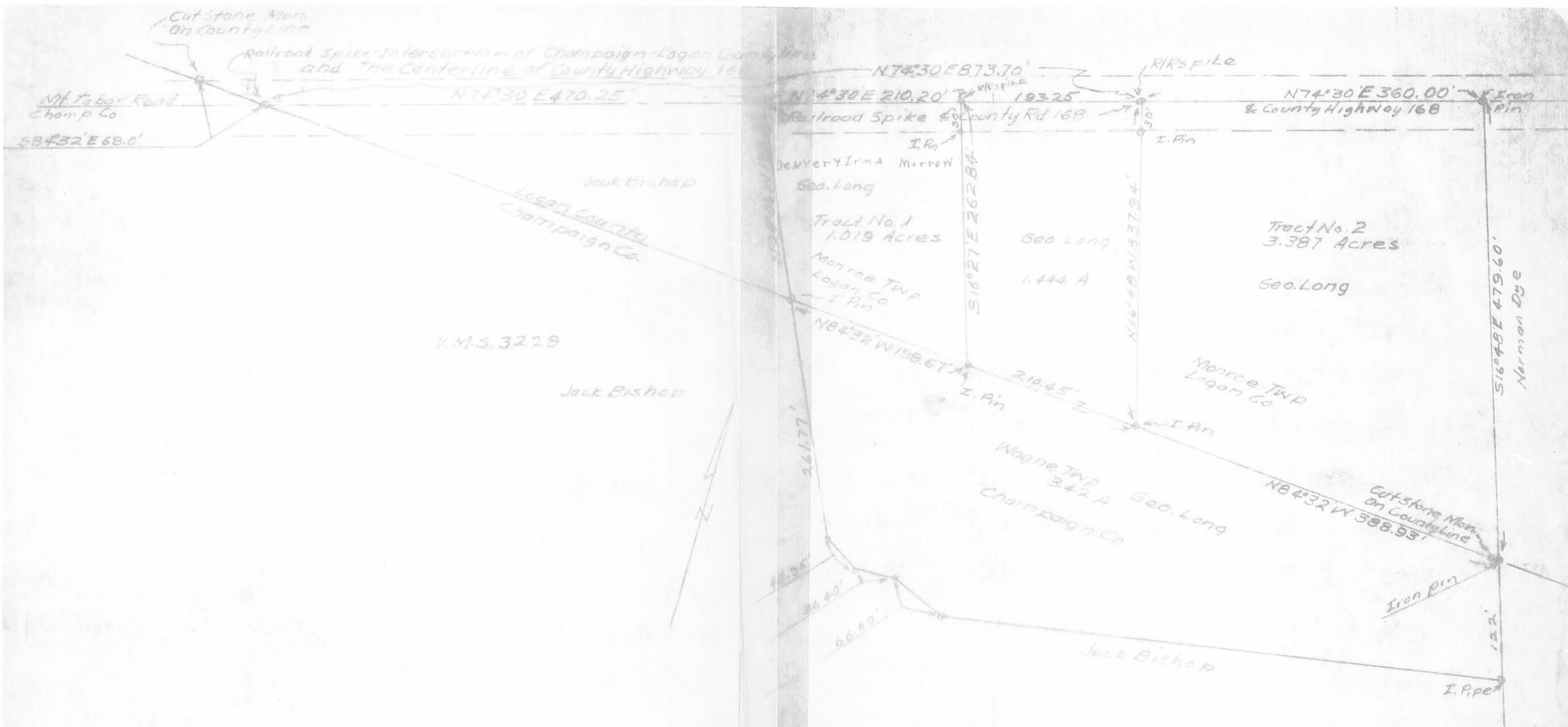
