thence following the northerly line of Krouskop's 47.43 acre tract, N $78^{\circ}-02$ '-00" W, 689.72 feet to a point in the center of Mad River passing thru the westerly right-of-way line of T.R. No. 166 at 25.15 feet,

thence following the centerline of Mad River along the following course: N $28^{\circ}-53^{\circ}-00^{\circ}$ E, 993.30 feet to a point; thence N $15^{\circ}-57^{\circ}-00^{\circ}$ E, 285.10 feet to a point; thence N $44^{\circ}-44^{\circ}-30^{\circ}$ E, 97.42 feet to a R.R. spike in the centerline of C.H. No. 29 being in the center of the "State Bridge",

thence following the centerline of C.H. No. 29, S 190-00'-00" E, 169.40 feet to the PLACE of BEGINNING.

The above described tract of land contains 12.11 acres of which 0.79 acre is dedicated for highway purposes.
