Being out of the Donald Lockwood 62.13 acre tract as deeded and described in Volume 350, Page 274 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set (replacing a PK nail found) on the centerline of County Highway 29 at the northeast corner of the said 62.13 acre tract.

THENCE, with the easterly lines of the said 62.13 acre tract and the westerly lines of the Harold Heilman 49.23 acre tract (Vol. 356, Pg. 12) the following two courses:

S 10°-32'-38" E, a distance of 648.33 feet to a 3/4 inch iron rod found.

S 29°-51'-46" E, a distance of 389.57 feet to a 3/4 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, S 78°-33'-13" W, a distance of 264.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, N 14°-37'-45" W, a distance of 843.96 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, N 66°-51'-45" W, a distance of 277.92 feet to a railroad spike set on the center-line of County Highway 29.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 29 the following two courses:

N 75°-38'-15" E, a distance of 194.27 feet to a PK nail found at Station 100+54 of the Logan County Engineer's center-line survey found in Field Book 573, Page 16.

N 76°-41'-30" E, a distance of 232.91 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 4.963 acres of which 0.288 acre is within the highway right-of-way.

The basis for bearings is based upon the center-line of County Highway 29 being N 75°-38'-15" E to the west of said Station 100+54 and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by Lee Surveying and Mapping Company on March 26, 1992.







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SURVEY FOR RUBY LOCKWOOD 4.001 Acres December 14, 2020

The following described 4.001 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Monroe, and V.M.S. 3222, being part of Ruby E. Lockwood, Trustee's 57.167 acre Tract II described in Official Record 936, page 249, and said 4.001 acre tract being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a railroad spike found at an angle point in the centerline of County Road 29 (50° R/W), said spike referenced as being at Sta. 87+00 in Logan County Engineer field book 573 on page 16;

Thence North 75°06'45" East (assumed bearing) 612.26 feet, following the centerline of County Road 29, to a magnetic nail set on the north line of said 54.167 acre tract, and marking the place of beginning;

Thence North 75°06'45" East 314.76 feet, following the centerline of County Road 29 and the north line of said 57.167 acre tract, to a magnetic nail set;

Thence South 11°54'56" East 554.44 feet, departing from the centerline of said road and entering said 57.167 acre tract, passing at 25.03 feet an iron pin set, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 75°06'45" West 314.76 feet, continuing through said 57.167 acre tract, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 11°54'56" West 554.44 feet, continuing through said 57.167 acre tract, passing at 529.41 feet an iron pin set, to the *place of beginning, containing 4.001 acres*, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record. Of the above described 4.001 acre tract, 0.181 acre is within the right of way of County Road 29.





Thence South 75°06'45" West 32.12 feet, continuing through said 57.167 acre tract, to a point;

Thence North 35°48'00" West 42.79 feet, continuing through said 57.167 acre tract, to a point;

Thence North 46°50'56" West 76.66 feet, continuing through said 57.167 acre tract, to a point;


