## SURVEY FOR DONALD ROPP 5.02 Acres March 26, 1978

Beginning, for reference, at a railroad spike found at the intersection of the centerlines of Logan County Road #171 and Logan County Road #28 (C.R.#28); thence following the centerline of C.R. #28 (50 feet wide), North 14° 50' West 455.00 feet to a railroad spike set and marking the principal place of beginning;

thence departing said road, South  $75^{\circ}$  10' West 230.00 feet, passing through an iron pin set at 25.00 feet on the westerly right-of-way line of said road, to an iron pin set;

thence North 370 19' West 379.11 feet to an iron pin set;

thence North 14° 50' West 300.00 feet to an iron pin set in the southerly line of Ellis J. Crabtree's 2.50 acre tract as described in Deed Volume 371, Page 247, Logan County Records;

thence following the southerly line of said Crabtree's 2.50 acre tract, North 75° 10' East 375.00 feet, passing through a reference iron pin found at 343.00 feet, to a railroad spike found on the centerline of C.R. #28, said spike marking the southeast corner of said Crabtree's tract;

thence following the centerline of C.R. #28, South 14° 50' East 650.28 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing 5.02 acres, more or less, and subject to any valid easements or restrictions of record.


