



5th May 1827 Survey no. 80 62

Surveyed 400 acres of land for John Enock. Beginning at a stake in the south west corner Piatt's land and in the west line of section 21 Town 5 Range 13 E.M.R. and 261 poles from the N.W. corner thereof - thence south with said line, passing the S.W. corner of said sec. at 60 poles 111 poles to a stake in the west line of sec. 20 where a bur oak tree & 40 links distant - thence S 87° 2' E 598 poles to a stake in Ludlow's line, a white oak tree & 20 W 40 links distant - thence with said line S 19° W 118 poles to 3 small hickories, black oak and cherry tree - back to south east corner to said Piatt's land - thence with the south line thereof S 87° 2' W 556 poles to the beginning containing 400 acres

Surveyed 100 acres of land for John Enock. - Beginning at a stake in the east line of section 14 Town 5 Range 13 E.M.R. where the south line of Osborn's land crosses said line thence with said line south 103 poles to a stake in the north line of McCarlney's land - thence with the north of said McCarlney's land east 45 3.8 poles to a white oak 33 623 links dist - thence north 104 poles, a white oak 114' E 20 links dist - thence a white oak S 87° W 22 links in Osborn's line - thence with said line west 15 3.8 poles to the beginning containing 100 acres in the north west corner of said sec.
