





Thence North 73°02′35″ East 922.77 feet, following the north line of V.M.S. 4479, the south line of V.M.S. 6516, the north line of said 17.016 acre tract and the south line of said 1.170 acre tract, passing at 148.54 feet a 5/8 inch iron bar found at the southwest corner of F. Philip Hess' and Kathy J. Hess' Exhibit "A" (30.079 acres) described in Official Record Volume 1411, page 4850, following the south line of said 30.079 acre tract thereafter, to an iron bar set and marking the place of beginning;

Thence **North 73°02'35" East 571.83 feet**, following the north line of V.M.S. 4479, the south line of V.M.S. 6516, the north line of said 17.016 acre tract and the south line of said 30.079 acre tract, to a stone found at the northwest corner of John A. Marshall's and Elizabeth J. Marshall's remainder of a 15.48 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 81, page 866;

Thence **South 13°34'25" East 110.97 feet**, departing from the south line of V.M.S. 6516 and the south line of said 30.079 acre tract, entering V.M.S. 4479, following the west line of the

remainder of said 15.48 acre tract and the east line of said 17.016 acre tract, passing a 5/8 inch iron bar found at 77.79 feet, to a magnetic nail found in the centerline of Township Road 164 (variable right-of-way width)(highway plan X-164A);

Thence **South 51°08'24" West 615.67 feet**, following the centerline of Township Road 164 and the south line of said 17.016 acre tract, to a magnetic nail found;

Thence continuing along the centerline of Township Road 164 and the south line of said 17.016 acre tract along a curve to the right, having a radius of 1143.94 feet, a delta angle of 00°46′55″, an arc length of 15.61 feet and a chord which bears **South 51°31′51″ West 15.61 feet**, to a magnetic nail set;

Thence **North 13°34′25″ West 346.77 feet**, departing from the centerline of Township Road 164 and crossing said 17.016 acre tract, passing an iron bar set at 33.06 feet, to the **place of beginning, containing 3.000 acres** more or less and subject all valid easements and restrictions of record.

The road right-of-way of Township Road 164 (variable right-of-way width) contains 0.435 acres more or less.


