DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR HARR FARMS Common Access Driveway Easement October 10, 2020

The following described common access driveway easement is situated in Virginia Military Survey 4479, Monroe Township, Logan County, Ohio and being over JOLBH, LLC's Tract II (5.857 acres) described in Official Record Volume 1369, page 121, said common access driveway easement being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a railroad spike found at the intersection of the centerline of Township Road 166 (60 feet wide) (Logan County engineer's field book 710, pages 37 thru 40) with the centerline of Township Road 164 (variable right-of-way width) (highway plan X-164A), said railroad spike being at the northwest corner of said 5.857 acre tract and being in a curve in the centerline of Township Road 166, having a radius of 206.28 feet, an arc length of 106.71 feet and a delta angle of 29°38′27″;


