Hall - Ferryman Survey East Liberty Perry Township Feb. 1961 0.15 Acre

The following described land in Perry Township, Logan County Ohio and being in the Village of East Liberty and in V.M.S. 4689

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of County Road Number 152 and Main Street of said Village of East Liberty and being station 142 plus 58 of said County Road Number 152 as shown on page 73 of Logan County Engineer's Field Book Number 555

Thence with the center of Main Street N. 33 - 26 W. 380.40 feet to an iron pin said pin being the beginning point of this survey. Said beginning point being the N.W. corner of Kenton Ferryman's 1.02 acre tract as now shown on Logan County Auditor's Land Duplicate and also being the S.W. corner of Chas. W. Brinser's 0.67 acre tract.

Thence with the south line of said Brinser's 0.67 acre tract N. 56 - 34 E. 86.00 feet to an iron. The last described line passing an iron at the east side of Main Street at 40.00 feet.
Thence S. 32 - 50 E. 77.40 feet to an iron.

Thence S. 36 - 19 W. 40.40 feet to an iron.

Thence with the north side of D. Kerns 0.01 acre tract N. 78 - 58 W. 67.25 feet to an iron in the center of Main Street. The last described line passing an iron at the east side of Main Street at 11.70 feet (Being 40.00 feet from the center line when measured at right angles)

Thence with the center line of Main Street N. 33 - 26 W. 44.15 feet to the place of beginning.

Said described tract containing 0.15 of one acre.
