THENCE, with the northerly right-of-way line of a 16.5 feet wide alley and the southerly line of Lot 13, S 52°-30'-22"W, a distance of 112.19 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set on the southwest corner of Lot 13.

THENCE, with the easterly right-of-way of a 16.5 feet wide alley and the westerly line of Lots 13 and 14, N 37°-23'-17"W, a distance of 100.18 feet to the point of beginning.


