LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR WATSON 0.437 ACRE TRACT

. Being situate in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Perry, Village of East Liberty, and being a part of Virginia Military Survey 4689 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a railroad spike found at 0.25'(feet) below grade at the intersection of the centerlines of Hamilton Avenue (74'(foot) right-of-way) and College Street (variable width right-of-way), also known as County Road 170;

thence with the centerline of said Hamilton Avenue, S-37°45'25"-E, 24.01'(feet) to a point;

thence S-50°30'12"-W, 37.04'(feet) to an iron bar set on the Westerly line of Hamilton Avenue, said iron bar set being the **PRINCIPLE PLACE BEGINNING** for the tract herein after described, passing for reference a 1"(one inch) diameter iron pipe found 0.1'(foot) below grade at 34.79'(feet);

thence with the Westerly line of Hamilton Avenue, S-37°45'25"-E, 114.07'(feet) to an iron bar set at the Northeasterly corner of a 0.250 acre tract owned by Jean Sigler as recorded in Deed Volume 228, Page 380 of the Logan County Deed Records, from which a 1"(one inch) diameter iron pipe found 0.15'(foot) below grade bears, N-51°17'11"-E, 2.22'(feet);

thence with the Northerly line of said Sigler's tract, S-51°17'11"-W, 168.79'(feet) to an iron bar set on the Easterly line of State Street (48'(feet) right-of-way);

thence with the Easterly line of State Street, N-37°39'00"-W, 111.76'(feet) to an iron bar set on the Southerly line of aforementioned College Street;

thence with the Southerly line of College Street, N-50°30'12"-E, 168.64'(feet) to the place beginning;

Containing 0.437 acre but being subject to the rights of all legal highways and all easements of record.

Being a more accurate description, per a field survey, of the 0.620 acre tract conveyed to Steven K. Watson by Deed recorded in Official Record 189, Page 268 of the Logan County Records

The foregoing description prepared by and in accordance with a survey by William D. Edwards, Professional Surveyor No.7574, June 17, 1999. All iron bars set are 5/8" X 30" iron re-bar with yellow plastic cap stamped "EDWARDS PS 4792 PS 7574". The basis of bearings for the herein described tract is the centerline of Hamilton Avenue per an assumed bearing of S-37°45'25"-E.
