



Hereinafter is described a right of way parcel for channel purpose with a total area of about 0.04 acre out of the southerly part of the 97.3 acre tract described in Deed Book 258, Page 171 and said parcel is southeasterly of and to the right of the existing right of way of State Route No. 292.
