thence North 70°23' West 429.60 feet to an iron pin set;

thence North 12<sup>0</sup>12' East 352.52 feet, passing through an iron pin set at 327.52 feet on the southerly right-of-way line of C.R. #2, to a railroad spike set on the centerline of said road also being on the north line of V.M.S. No. 4813;

thence following the centerline of C.R. #2 and the north line of V.M.S. 4813, South 78°23' East 424.16 feet to the principal place of beginning.

The above described tract of land contains 3.73 acres, of which 0.24 acre is dedicated for highway purposes.
