Thence

running along a new division line on the following two (2) courses and distances:

1. N.84°10'44"W., a distance of 1674.76 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set, passing a 5/8" iron pin set at 30.00 feet;

2. N.05°00'41"E., a distance of 820.02 feet to 5/8" iron pin set;

Thence

along the north line of said southeast quarter & the north line of Pleasant Township, S.84°17'04"E., a distance of 1671.92 feet to the Point of Beginning, passing a 5/8" iron pin found at 1631.92 feet;




INDEXED ON MAP
