MILLER 5.000 ACRES

Lying in Virginia Military Survey 9971, Richland Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being out of the David Miller and Regina Miller 104.25 acre tract as deeded and described in Official Record 858, Page 758 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on a 1 inch iron rod found on center-line Station 49 + 45.57 (Logan County Engineer's Field Book 708, Page 3) of County Highway 97.

THENCE, with the northerly line of the Ronald C. Roebuck 73.65 acre tract (O.R. 369, Pg. 686), S 83°-15'-15"W, a distance of 832.10 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 32.01 feet.

THENCE, N 9°-37'-02"W, a distance of 276.95 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, N 83°-15'-15"E, a distance of 742.98 feet to a railroad spike set on the center-line of County Highway 97, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 710.97 feet.

THENCE, with the center-line of County Highway 97 (60 feet wide), S 27°-10'-06"E, a distance of 295.15 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 5.000 acres, of which 0.203 acre is within the highway right-of-way.

The basis for bearings is the center-line of County Highway 97 between Stations 49+45.57 and 68+84.63, being N $27^{\circ}-10'-06''$ W, and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by Lee Surveying and Mapping Co., Inc. on April 24, 2007.
