The following tracts of land at Big Springs in V.M.S. 9956 (state High way NO.5%) Rushcreek Township, Logan County, Ohio. Tract # 1

Beginning at a railroad spike at the apparent centers of the Rushsylvania and Big Springs Pike known as county Road # 9 and Road # 265 thence N. 31. 0' E. with center of said road # 9, 250.8 feet to the S.W. corner of George Mulligan tract, thence S. 64.0' E. 136 feet to a 2" Iron Pipe, thence N. 89.45 E. 88 feet to a post at L.K.Brulger's S.W. corner thence continuing N. 89.45'E. with said Brugler's S. line 149 feet to a concrete part at west right of way fence of C.C.C.& St.L.R.R. said post being 50' feet (st right angles) from center line of west track of said railroad thence in a southerly direction and 50 feet west of center of west track 352 feet to center of said road # 265, thence N. 68_37'W. with center of said road # 266, 260.8 feet to place of beginning said tract containgin 1.70 Acres more or less and being same tract as surveyed May 1955 as shown in (state Highway No. 579) Logan County Surveyor's Book 570 Page 26.


Tract # 2

Beginning at a railroad spike at the apparent center of the Rushsylvania Big Springs Pike, known as toad # 9 and road # 265 thence with center of raod # 9 S. 41.02 W. 103 feet, thence easterdly about 229 feet to a post 50 feet west of center of west tract of C.C.C. & St. L.R.R. thence northerly and 50 feet west of center of said west tract 184 feet to center of road # 264 thence with center of said road # 264 S.68 37' W. 260.6 feet to place of beginning, said tract contain. ing .79 of one acre more or less and being same tract as surveyed May 1933 as shown and recorded in Logar County Surveyor's Book 570 Page 26.

Tract # 3

Beginning at the apparent center of the Big Springs Pike (known as road # 12) and center of road # 265 thence N.45_23 E. with center of road #12 262 feet for the beginning part of this survey thence with center of road # 12 N. S6_23'E. 820.7 feet to a past at S.W. corner of R.S. Watson & Acre tract, thence N.6_22' W. with said Watson's north Acre line 167 feet to the west Right Of Way line of C.C.C. & St.L.R.R. thence southerly with said Right Of Way line to place of beginning said tract containing .42 of one acre and being same tract as surveyed May 1905 as shown and recorded in Logan County Surveyor's Book 570 Page 26.

DESCRIPTION.

Right of way one hundred feet in width for so much of said Railroad, as may pass through the following described piece, parcel or lot of land, to wit:

Part of Survey No.9956 in the Virginia
Military District, beginning at a beech in the North
boundary of the original survey, thence N.12° W. 90
poles from the center of the bed of the Spring running
with old line from said beech; thence No.78° E. 434
poles to a stake near a white ash elm and blue ash in
said line; thence S. 12° E. 110 poles to a stake near
two small hickories and small white oak; thence S.78°
W. 87½ poles to a stake near a beech and sugar tree;
thence N. 12° W. 110 poles to a stake near a sugar tree
and beech in the original line; thence with the line
N.78°E.434 poles to the beginning. Containing 60 acres.

DESCRIPTION

The right of way for railroad purposes one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet on each side of the center line of the tracks of said Company, for so much of the railway of said Company as now located as passes through the following described land situate in the County of Logan, and State of Ohio, to-wit:

Part of Survey 9956, beginning at a stone North East Corner of the old Curtis Farm, thence north 79° East 100 6/10 poles to a stone & Burr oak; thence south $10\frac{1}{2}$ ° East 161 5/10 poles to a stone in the center of the County Road; thence North $74\frac{1}{4}$ ° West 111 5/10 poles to a stone at the angle of the Road; thence north $10\frac{1}{4}$ ° West with the East line of said Curtis Farm 111 8/10 poles to the beginning - 85 45/100 acres.
