Thence with the centerline of C. H. 25 N. 9° 57' 00" W. 37.10 feet to a magnetic nail set, passing a magnetic nail set at 22.10 feet.

Thence N. 85° 33' 00" E. 359.49 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set.

Thence S. 5° 30' 28" E. 351.98 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set.

Thence S. 83° 22' 00" W. 128.33 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set at the southeast corner of The Trustees of Rushcreek Township's 0.30 acre tract as described in D. B. Vol. 297 Page 193.

Thence with said east line N. 5° 31' 31" W. 75.50 feet to a point at the northeast corner of said cemetery.

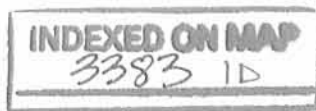

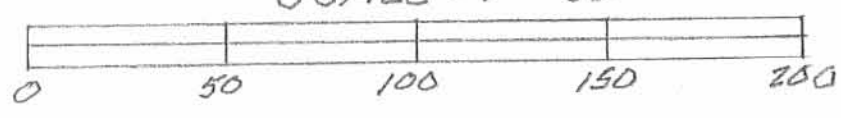

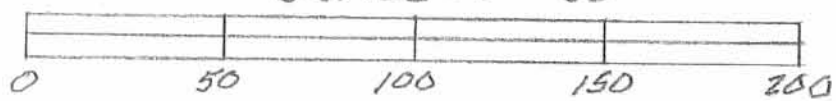
