Thence with the center of said Road Number 9 S. 35° - 39' W. 405.55 feet to an iron.

Thence with the east side of a 6.05 acre tract in the name of James Roby N. 5° - 17' W. 409.00 feet to an iron pipe at the N.E. corner of the said Roby 6.05 acre tract. Said pipe also being the S.E. corner of a 70.98 acre tract in the name of Neil Deicher.

Thence with the east side of said Deicher tract N. 5° - 02' W. 481.00 feet to a round wood post.

Thence S. 57° - 27' E. 583.00 feet to a small iron in the center of said road Number 9.

Thence with the center of said Road Number 9 S. 35° - 39' W. 299.30 feet to the place of beginning.
