Beginning at a railroad spike set on the center-line of County Highway 5, S 16°-56'-39" E, a distance of 154.94 feet from a railroad spike found at the northwest corner of the said 8.00 acre tract.

THENCE, through the said 8.00 acre tract, with the south line of a 1.701 acre tract surveyed simultaneously with this tract, N 76°-42'-27" E, a distance of 480.81 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the east line of the said 8.00 acre tract and a west line of the Robert Titus original 90.27 acre tract (0.R. 24, Pg. 861), S 12°-42'-44" E, a distance of 412.02 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.


