At N.W. 90th pole, to the N.E. corner of the Survey, in a County Road, S of the corner tree, here are cut down, and one dead, planted a stem in the ground of the chain men, Calvi. Plat Samuel Manoa v Adam Neary, them with the north line of the Survey N 79 W 68th pole to Rupel, at N corner, planted a stem, present as at last corner, also the Rupel. Continued the measure of the line, crossing Cherokee at 156th p., 163th & 172th pole from the N.E. corner of the Survey, reaching the 4th corner planted (see figure 4) at 282th pole. The dotted line on the plat was not measured, and the figures show the manner in which the Survey was made.
