

MEADAMS SURVEY

The following described real estate situate in the Village of Rushsylvania, Rushcreek Township, Logan County, Ohio and being in Ohio Virginia Survey No. 13446.

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Sandusky Street, (State Highway No. 579 - Route 274) at Station 368 + 03 as shown on sheet 7 of plan x-9 in the Logan County Engineers Office. Said iron pin also being in the southeast corner of a .25 acre tract of land belonging to Earl McAdams et ux; thence with the center of said street S. 36° - 21' W. 25.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 54° - 46' W. 458.0 feet to a stake in the east right-of-way fence of the C.C.C. & St. L. R.R. Co.; thence with said R.R. Co. right-of-way fence N. 8° - 59' E. 25.5 feet to a concrete post; thence continuing with said R.R. Co. right-of-way fence S. 60° - 57' E. 14.5 feet to a concrete post; thence continuing again with said R.R. Co. right-of-way fence N. 8° - 59' E. 826.5 feet to a post in LeVelle's southwest corner; thence with LeVelle's south line S. 58° - 00' E. 76.7 feet to a post; thence S. 55° - 38' E. 472.0 feet to a post in King's northwest corner; thence with King's west line S. 36° - 46' W. 290.3 feet to a stake; thence S. 54° - 30' E. 72.7 feet to a post thence S. 36° - 21' W. 461.3 feet to a post ~~in the~~ southwest corner of said McAdams .25 acre tract; thence with the south line of said .25 acre tract N. 54° - 46' E. 220.7 feet to the place of beginning containing 7.15 acres.

The above described tract being off the north end of a 9.60 acres tract belonging to Arza Hertenstein et ux May 1, 1945.
